COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 23-022
REGARDING FINDING OF SUITABILITY
AND LICENSURE OF TWO NINE SPORTS INC.

March 29, 2023

WHEREAS, Two Nine Sports, Inc. (the “Company”) has applied for a license to operate Fantasy Sports Contests pursuant to Sections 313.900, RSMo, et seq., as amended from time to time, and 11 CSR 45-40.010 et seq., as amended from time to time (collectively the “Missouri Fantasy Sports Consumer Protection Act and Regulations”).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Company is hereby found suitable by the Missouri Gaming Commission (the “Commission”) to hold a license to conduct Fantasy Sports Contests pursuant to the Missouri Fantasy Sports Consumer Protection Act and Regulations and that the Commission hereby grants a Fantasy Sports Contest Operator license to the Company to expire on November 1, 2023; and

RESOLVED, that the license granted to the Company as provided herein shall be subject to full and complete compliance with the Missouri Fantasy Sports Consumer Protection Act and Regulations and subject to any and all conditions set forth or that may be set forth in the Missouri Fantasy Sports Consumer Protection Act and Regulations or by the Commission, from time to time; and

RESOLVED, that the license granted to the Company as provided herein shall be subject to any penalty or to suspension or revocation based on any pending or subsequent investigative findings by the Commission with regard to the Company, its agents or employees; and

RESOLVED, that, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-1.030, the resolutions set forth herein do not indicate or suggest that the Commission has considered or passed in any way on the marketability of securities of the Company or any affiliate company or any other matter, except the matters set forth herein.
